
DEED HOUSE TO RED BANK

Eisner Brothers Donate \$25,000 Property for Use as Library.

RED BANK, N. J., Jan. 5.—The Borough Council accepted tonight a gift by H. Raymond, Monroe and J. Lester Eisner, brothers, of a three-story frame dwelling and large grounds on the Shrewsbury River to be used as a public library. The Eisner brothers gave the property, which was the home of their parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. Sigmund Eisner, as a memorial to their father and mother.

The mansion, which is valued with its lot at \$25,000, will not need much remodeling to make it suitable for library purposes. The deed of gift provided that if the borough should some day cease to use the building as a library the property is to be sold and the money given to Harvard University, of which the Eisner brothers are alumni. The borough maintains a public library now in a rented store in the business section here.
