Dear Friend,

The Red Bank Republicans are at it again, this time attempting to push through a controversial proposal to construct a massive Jersey City-style high rise structure right in the center of downtown Red Bank. Led by 25-year old Councilman Mike Whelan, the Republican Council Members think they can push through a plan without significant public input. **That is simply not true.**

Here's what you can do about it: Show up, speak out, and make your voice heard.

On Wednesday, June 14th, after the Red Bank Borough's regularly-scheduled 6:30pm meeting, there will be a Parking Committee meeting, led by Councilman Whelan. There will be a public presentation detailing the five current proposals for redevelopment of the 2.5 acre White Street Parking Lot. The proposals reach up to 12 stories, and each come with hundreds of apartment-style units and retail storefronts.

The solution to Red Bank's parking problem is not to drop a building three times the height of the Galleria right in the center of our flourishing downtown. **The Republican plan would quite literally cast a shadow across half of downtown Red Bank.**

On Wednesday, June 14th, show up and let Council Members Mike Whelan, Linda Schwabenbauer, and Mark Taylor know exactly what you think about these outlandish proposals.
